MANAGER'S NOTES

Today, we welcome Maidenhead Utd to the AJN Stadium and trust that they have had a safe journey down the M4 and the A4174 ring road to Keynsham.

Normally, our games have been pretty close, with the odd goal differential, but this season we lost heavily in the away fixture and so we have every incentive to correct that today.

That is despite long term injuries to three key players, Naomi Clipston, Lorna Coates and Lily





Nevertheless, that gives opportunities for other players to come in and show what they can do for the club. A good example is new dual signing Georgia Galley who will be making her home debut today having played for Southampton U21s on Friday at Aston Villa. We expect Georgia to be with us solely next season and see her as a mobile and talented forward. Injuries have meant a change of position from holding mid to full back for Nellie Bullock and a holding role for Lily Reed, plus an extended run at left back for Lucy Hilton-Jones.

Although this is our last home game of the season, we have two more fixtures. There is the Somerset County Senior Women's Cup final against Bridgwater at Paulton Rovers on Thursday 24th April with a 7.30pm kick off. Please note that admission for adults is £7 and £3 for concessions.

Our final League game of the season will be away at Abingdon on Sunday 27th April. That is the same date as our U16 JPL side play Bath City in the County U16 final at Middlezoy.

It is pleasing to report that 2 of these talented U16 side have already made their debuts for the Development squad and another eight have booked to join our trials, for which they have a priority, that start on Sunday May 11th. There is an advert for these elsewhere in the programme and we expect to have circa 30 participants in those trials.

Our development side play away at Queens Park Rangers on Sunday 20th April and finish their season at home to Moneyfields the following Sunday. That means that all our teams will have concluded their seasons by the 27th April and attention is already turning to planning

for the 2025-26 season.

May I thank all spectators for their support this season, hope they see an entertaining match today and wish everyone a very happy Easter next week.

Lastly a note re our chairman who had his knee operation over a week ago and is now home. He may even be here on crutches. We all wish him a speedy recovery. We'll soon get him running round the ground!!!



MATCH REPORT

BRISTOL ROVERS FINALLY WIN A LOCAL DERBY!

Bristol Rovers invited Keynsham Town to Mangotsfield United to play under the lights! Despite some light rain just before the warm up, the weather is holding up to the occasion as Keynsham prepare for the Bristol derby.

Rovers start bright, quickly finding their winger out wide. She sends the cross in and the oppositions striker is luckily there to clear it for a goal kick. A very quick wake up call for Keynsham.


