## Manager's notes

Today, we welcome Moneyfields for this FA Women's National League fixture. We trust that they have had a safe journey from the South Coast to the AJN Stadium.

Moneyfields have had a strong record of progress and have made a particularly good start to this season. They currently lie in third place in Division One South West, having won two games against Maidenhead and away at Abingdon. They lost narrowly to Bournemouth at home, but had previously knocked them out of the League Cup. This all is an achievement in a location competing with both Bournemouth and Portsmouth for players and attention.



So, all the indications are that the game today will be very competitive.

Our game last Sunday at home to Southampton ended in controversy with the opposition not willing to restart the game after a thunderstorm. A great deal of pressure was put on the young referee, who had acted in line with the guidance for such situations and refused to be bullied.

We have been asked to submit a report as Southampton have been which the League will consider along with the referee's report as to allowing the result to stand (the score was 5-0 in the 82nd minute) or if there has to be a replay of the fixture.

In a surprising turn of events, Southampton have sent us a copy of their report, stating that on reflection they do not seek to have the game replayed. Originally, Southampton had pushed for a replay as they are expecting to strengthen their side with more signings in due course.

Therefore, it seems the odds may be slightly in favour of the result standing, but you never know what the League authorities will decide in such a case. We should hear in the next couple of weeks. The outcome will make a material difference to our league position, either fourth from the top or third from the bottom.

Our young Development squad had a very pleasing opening win away at Maidenhead Development in the determining round of the Reserve Cup, with Jenna B coming off the bench to score the winner. As a result, the team goes into the League Cup proper with Maidenhead entering the Plate competition. The draw for the Reserve League Cup has been made and we have been drawn away to Swindon Town, with the tie being scheduled for Sunday 29th September, with the replaced fixture v Cheltenham having to be rearranged for later.

Similarly, the draw for the First team Plate competition has been made and we have been given a home tie against Bristol Rovers next Sunday, the 15th September. This will now replace the scheduled home game against Worthing, which will need to be rearranged for a later date.

Our young Development side have an away fixture today, ironically also against Moneyfields, which will be their first League match.

Saturday, as I write this article for the programme, sees out U16 team play their JPL Cup match at home against Yeovil Town. I will not know the result before I finish this note, but if there is room for a stop press entry, I will try to get it posted later in the programme.

Let's hope we see a good game of football today.

## SECRETARY'S VIEWS

Today we welcome Moneyfields to the AJN Stadium whilst our Development team travel in the opposite direction to play Moneyfields Reserves.

Let's hope we don't have torrential rain and thunder and lightening such as we experienced last Sunday in our game against Southampton Women, although some is forecast in the South West. We were winning 5 nil when the referee called players off the pitch with 82 minutes on the clock leaving 10 minutes left to be played including injury time. It used to be that if 70 minutes of the game had been played then the result would stand but that has changed this year and the full 90 minutes have to be played. The referee made every effort to restart the game and eventually all players came out on the pitch ready to play the 10 minutes. Southampton decided they did not want to play however and walked off the pitch refusing to play although instructed by the referee to do so. By that time the storm had abated and indeed aeroplanes were flying overhead from Bristol Airport, not renowned for flying in bad weather conditions.

Initially Southampton were trying to claim the game was abandoned which it was not as they refused to play. The referee has put in her report and the League has asked both teams for their reports and I submitted ours with full input from our coach who had all the timings. I understand it will now go to a Women's Board meeting to decide if the result stands or not. I have since heard from Southampton that in their report they have stated that they wish to waive any possible option of a replay as in the interests of sportsmanship and fairness we had clearly won the game. They are still very critical of the referee, however, who we thought handled the situation very well and refused to be intimidated. We now wait to see what is decided.

At the moment the result is still standing on FA Full Time which puts us in fourth place. The result kept being changed to A-A by the other team but I kept changing it back!!

We hope for an enjoyable competitive game today – with no thunder and lightning storms!

## **Moneyfields F.C. Women**

Since launching the team in 2017, Portsmouth-based Moneyfields FC Women have climbed the women's football pyramid with successive promotions through the Hampshire FA Women's Leagues and the Southern Region Women's Leagues.

In May 2022, after two seasons lost to COVID, they finally secured a much-deserved promotion into the FA Women's National League South West Division One, the fourth tier of women's football.



The team's first season in the National League was a huge success, the team finished in the top three, above established sides like AFC Bournemouth, Southampton Women and Swindon Town.

The following season saw Moneyfields equal their third-place finish but unable to keep pace with AFC Bournemouth and the eventual winners Exeter City.

The highlights of the season included their Adobe Women's FA Cup run which saw Karl Watson's team reach the Fourth Round, overcoming Ashford Town, Haringey Borough and Millwall before exiting the competition at the hands of Women's Championship side, London City Lionesses 4-0.

Moneyfields rounded off a record-breaking season by lifting a trophy in their final match against AFC Portchester. Goals from Kau'inohea Taylor and Megan Fox in either half were enough to earn Moneys a 2-0 victory over AFC Portchester in the Portsmouth Divisional FA Cup Final.

So far this season, Moneyfields have three wins from four matches. They opened the season with a 4-0 win against Maidenhead United thanks to a brace from Charley Wilson-Wilton and new signing Shannon Albuery.

This match was particularly special as it marked the team's first competitive home game in 897 days, following extensive delays in the refurbishment of their ground, now proudly named the John Jenkins Stadium.

In their last two outings, they had the daunting task of AFC Bournemouth, Steve Cuss' side missing out on promotion by two points despite going unbeaten in the league all season. In the first encounter, Moneyfields secured a dramatic 4-3 with the winner in the final moments of extra time. After taking an early 1-0 lead in the league match four days later the Cherries rescued the three points with two goals in the final four minutes.

### Match Report

#### KEYNSHAM DOWN SORRY SOUTHAMPTON STRENS!

Kevnsham welcomed Southampton Women to the AJN Stadium for their latest League fixture - for the visitors this was their first game of the new season having postponed their first two games for administrative reasons.

Klaudia is quickly tested early after only 4 minutes of play as she's fast off her line to clear a through ball from Southampton. Keynsham respond well with Lily W rattling the crossbar.

Immy is quick to not let Southampton clear the ball. With a clever through ball to Naomi and a collected finish from the captain, Keynsham goes ahead. 1-0 Keynsham! (12mins)

Keynsham keep up the pressure on the Southampton defence, winning them a corner. And a well delivered corner sees Keynsham go 2-0 up! Our captain Naomi grabbing her second.

Southampton aren't giving up without a fight with some good defensive work from the back four. Nellie even putting her face on the line, with an elbow to her eye. But after landing on her arm, the team get a well deserved water break whilst she gets some treatment.

Straight off the bat, Jade and Naomi show good link up. Naomi manages to send the goalkeeper the wrong way, only for the ball to trickle wide. Nellie's defensive duties are called into action as she manages to drop to block a clever through ball from Southampton.

At 25 minutes, Keynsham strike gold again. Ciera dances round the Southampton defence to strike the ball into the bottom corner. 3-0 Keynsham!

Keynsham are showing great team chemistry on the pitch. With some clever one touch play, starting with our goalkeeper, Lily W wins Keynsham another corner, Immi's header from the corner going just wide.

Keynsham's link up play showcased yet again between Nellie, Bea and Nay, Scarlett gets on the end of a through ball but the ball gets blasted over the bar.

Despite a guieter half, Klaudia remains alert and is guick off her line to clear another ball from Southampton.

Keynsham are determined to get their fourth and keep the pressure on Southampton high as Nav wins another corner. Scarlett delivers a good cross to Jade, who headers it wide. Scarlett drives the ball past two defenders and gets a shot off at the goalkeeper, who demonstrated some impressive handling.

At 42 minutes, Lily W gets the goal she's been dreaming of. After muscling off a defender to win the ball back, she smashes the ball into the top right corner from 40 yards out! Cracking goal! Keynsham finally get their fourth.

You'd think that would be it until half time but Keynsham strikes again. A great team goal starting from a neat bit of link up between Klaudia and Nell. Nay clatters into the Southampton goalkeeper, winning a 50/50 challenge and the ball ends up in the back of the net. Our captain has her hattrick!!

After 8 minutes the substitutions are made. Nay, Bea, Ciera, Scarlett and Jade replaced for Vicky, Lily R, Sophie, Hannah and Liv, Vicky is straight into the action as she wins the ball back from the defence and forces an impressive stop from the Southampton goalkeeper.

Scrappy play from Keynsham causes Klaudia to be alert as she pulls off a good stop to her right post. Two minutes later she is called into action again as she displays some solid handling from a far out shot.

Southampton are relieving Keynsham of any pressure. Lorna gives us another masterclass in defending as she holds off the striker and perfectly times a sliding tackle to give Southampton a throw in.

Lily R relieves some pressure for Keynsham as she dances round three Southampton players. What a crowd pleaser!

Keynsham getting back into form with some good build up play from Vicky, Liv and Lily W. Keynsham win a free kick in a dangerous area as Lily R takes. Vicks gets a volley off but it falls just wide. Sophie and Hannah now providing good width for the Keynsham attack.

Keynsham are determined to get the first goal of the second half. Vicky and Sophie win the ball back from the defence, allowing Immi to get a shot away from a hard angle.

Southampton's defence are holding on with a little bit of help from our own. Sophie helps them out as she blocks a shot from Vicky. However it's not long before Vicky is back again, whose shot forces the Southampton goalkeeper to make a very good save to her left.

At 82 minutes the ref stops the match due to lightening forecasts. After 45minutes of delayed play, the referee decided it is safe to continue. However, our opponents refuse to continue play, and so the result of the match is in the leagues hands.


