MANAGER'S NOTES

Today's home match is, it appears, the only home evening game that we will play this season. There will be one away game in February when we will play the reverse fixture against today's opponents Bristol Rovers.

As such, this is a welcome reduction in evening games from the historic level of four such fixtures.

While evening games are a bit special for players who find any match under floodlights interesting, they are somewhat disruptive to the normal preparation for Sunday games. A good example being this Sunday,



when we make the longest possible journey to Worthing for the next round of the FA Women's National League Plate competition. Now we are unable to train tonight in preparation for that tie.

With the result of the home game against Southampton still not determined by the League, we had slumped to a position three from the bottom of the divisional table and with just one point. Therefore, last weekend's trip to Bournemouth Sports took on extra significance as it offered the opportunity to get a more acceptable position in the table. This message was taken on board by the players, plus the fact that newly promoted Bournemouth Sports had a record of both scoring and conceding very few goals. This all suggested a rather close encounter. So, to come away with a 6-1 victory was more than we had expected and has pushed us up to a comfortable sixth place in the division.

There are two players who stand out here, Naomi Clipston with another hat-trick bringing her goal tally to 10 goals in seven matches. Secondly, Ciera Lundy with another goal from midfield (five in seven games) and two more assists. Out midfield has now recorded 7 goals, which is one per game.

Our Development side were warned that their home game with AFC Bournemouth would be very hard. Bournemouth are another club with too many players and a huge wage bill.

We were more than good value for holding them to 2-2 in the first half, but ran out of steam in the second half to lose 8-3. The only game that will be tougher this season will be the away fixture.

On Sunday, the Development should have a more even match away at Swindon Town in the FAWNL League Cup. The following week (6/10) there is a gap in the fixture list and they have a friendly at home to Bristol University kicking off at 2pm.

SECRETARY'S VIEWS

Once again we welcome Bristol Rovers Women to the AJN Stadium. This time for an important League game.

Some supporters have asked why our game against Southampton Women is showing on FA Full Time as being abandoned (A-A) when the opposition refused to play the last 10 minutes, following a thunder and lightning storm. It it my understanding that any game that does not run the full 90 minutes is now marked as abandoned as the default setting pending investigation. As far as the Club is aware the matter is awaiting a decision by the Women's Board following reports being submitted by both clubs and the referee. So either we will be awarded the points or the game will be ordered to be replayed.

Another last minute change of referee this evening. This seems to be happening a lot just lately. Apparently there is a shortage of referees available in the pool and, we are told, this is why so many of the referees appointed travel long distances to reach us, and we end up with high costs, even with a cap. Also I understand referees need to put in so many games ant a certain level if they wish to progress further. The game needs referees at all levels and there are several referee courses offered by both the Somerset FA and the Gloucestershire FA if anyone is interested.

Recent news - we have been drawn away to AEK Boco Ladies in The Adobe Women's FA Cup on Sunday 13th October. AEK Boco currently play in the Premier Division of The Regen Arable South West Womens Regional Regional Football League.

There are no games here on Sunday. The First team are away to Worthing in the FAWNL Plate and the Development are away to Swindon Development in the FAWNL Reserve Cup.

Bristol Rovers F.C. Women

Bristol Rovers Women's are an English Women's football club situated in the north of Bristol.

The club relaunched in the spring of 2019 by Bristol Rovers Community Trust with a focus on community, education, participation and performance.

The former club was founded in the 1980's and enjoyed success in the regional leagues and a run to the semi finals of the FA Cup in 2001, losing to eventual winners Arsenal, and they reached the semi final stage of the competition on a further two

occasions. In 2005 the club became known as Bristol Academy WFC.

With no women's team representing Bristol Rovers for 14 years, Nathan Hallett-Young and Matthew Davies founded the re-launched club with Community Trust CEO, Adam Tutton as Chairman.

From 2019 until the summer of 2024 the club remained under the stewardship of the Community Trust, rising through the leagues with promotions in the 20/21 season, 21/22 season and although narrowly missing out on promotion in 22/23 by just One point, there was a further promotion in 23/24 promoting the club to its current position in the Women's National League Division 1 South West.

During the summer of 2024, the club transferred to the management of Bristol Rovers Football Club, cementing the team as a part of the football club with training at the club training ground (The Quarters) and home games being played at the Memorial Stadium.

The club continues under the management of Nathan Hallett-Young supported by Chris Douglas as Assistant Manager, with Deb Phillips as Operations Manager. First team captain is Rianne Bourne-Hallett.

Match REPORT

KEYNSHAM STEPPED ON THE GAS AGAINST ROVERS

Keynsham Town LFC hosted Bristol Rovers WFC at the AJN Stadium on Sunday the 15th September in the preliminary round of the FA WNL plate.

Keynsham start brightly with a few quick chances. Nay fed the ball through to Scarlett who smashed a dipping volley against the bar. Her first goal for Keynsham firsts cannot get any closer!

A soft foul awarded against Vicky sees Rovers able to relieve some pressure. They look to get the ball to their striker, but the linesman flags for offside.

Rovers high press pays off, giving them a brief chance. But Keynsham's defence is well organised.

After superb link up play between Nay, Scarlett and Lily W, the latter makes a run into the box but her shot is straight at the keeper. While, Jade and Lorna work brilliantly together to keep Rovers at bay. Rovers finally get Klaudia into action as she's forced to deal with an awkward cross.

19mins: Lily W wins Keynsham a penalty! A great run across the box leaves Rovers no choice but to take her out. Nay slots the penalty away as cool as you like. 1-0 Keynsham!!!

Rovers look shaken as Keynsham come again, Nay unfortunately forced onto her left and the shot ends comfortably into the keepers hands. Bea runs a marathon for Keynsham down the line, eventually winning the team a corner. The corner is well delivered but Jade just heads the ball over.

Both teams fighting for it in the middle. Ciera breaks free and releases the ball to Vicky. She gets a shot away from far out, which is comfortably saved by the Rovers keeper. Rovers striker finally gets free from Jade's grasp but her shot is denied by Klaudias quick reactions.

Rovers almost take advantage of a miscommunication in the Keynsham defence, but Emma and Lorna work hard to get back and clean up.

Rovers win a free kick, But Keynsham hit Rovers on the counter after Ciera clears the dangerous cross, Bea gets the ball wide to Scarlett who delivers a good ball to Nay, But sadly Keynsham were narrowly offside.

A dodgy back pass back to Klaudia sees Rovers get a corner. Keynsham hold on, with some great strength shown from Ciera and Vicky. Nay releases the ball to Scarlett who gets a well deserved breather for the home side.

Rovers are getting desperate but Keynsham hold on. Vicky puts her body on the line and wins Keynsham a free kick. Keynsham almost get a second as Bea challenges the Rovers goalkeeper, causing the ball to bounce over her head. Rovers get lucky as the ball falls just wide of the post.

HT: Kevnsham 1-0 Rovers.

Rovers start with a fight and Keynsham work hard to keep them at bay. Former Keynsham player, Jarvis, puts a challenge on our goalkeeper to block her pass out, but Klaudia's is guick to the rebound.

The game is a little scrappy - a typical local derby, which feels it could boil over.

51 mins: Keynsham strike gold!! - a free kick to Keynsham sees Nay deliver a superb cross which is met by Vicky with a bullet header straight into the bottom corner 2-0 Keynsham!!

55mins: Deja Vu! - Nay with another fantastic cross from a Keynsham free kick. This time Bea gets her head to it, flicking it through the keeper's hands into the net. 3-0 Keynsham!!

Scarlett puts some great pressure on the Rovers defence and wins the ball back for the home side. She goes on a run, dancing round the defence and eventually allowing Nay to get a shot away, which sadly goes wide.

MATCH REPORTS

67mins: Heads up! Keynsham score yet another header. Cracking cross from Emma leads to a looping header by Ciera over the keepers stretch. 4-0 Keynsham!

With 20mins to go, Hannah and Lily R replace Nay and Bea for a well deserved rest.

Rovers aren't giving up just yet. Lily W forces the player wide giving her a hard angle, causing the shot to go wide. Not long after, Emma provides a crunching tackle to keep Keynsham on top.

With 12 mins to go, Liv and Sophie come on for Scarlett and Jade.

Nellie, Lily R and Ciera have great control of midfield, as Keynsham are commanding and putting in a superb team performance.

Sophie and Vicky, get the ball to Ciera on the edge of the box but her shot just lacks power,

With 10 to go, Rovers finally find the net. Good defending from Liv but the ball just couldn't get cleared, Rovers take a cracking shot, Klaudia unlucky to not keep it out the net, 4-1,

Keynsham respond well. Vicky holds up the ball in the box and finds Ciera on the edge. Ciera draws a great save from the Rovers keeper.

Klaudia calms the game down for Keynsham with a great take from a cross, and some nice game management.

In the final few minutes, Rovers are huffing and puffing, but Keynsham aren't done. Lily R brilliant pass - after a superb touch by Nellie - sees Hannah drive forward and fire narrowly over.

And the full time whistle goes. Keynsham fought and proved that Bristol is in fact green (if we pretend Bristol City doesn't exist).

BOURNEMOUTH WEAR DOWN BATTLING DEVS

Keynsham entertained last season's Reserve League Champions, AFC Bournemouth Devs, for their first home fixture of the season.

Keynsham made a bright start with some nice passing and looked to get on the front foot. Maddie made a great pinch - just as the bench were thinking she could shoot - slips it inside to Jess A who fires in a 35 yard thunderbolt!! (1-0)

Bournemouth are rattled - Keynsham are standing firm - Good defending by Tilly then Mandy H. Liv gave away an indirect free kick after she was adjudged to have touched the ball before Chloe collected - Keynsham clear.

Chloe a great punch from a dangerous cross, before Mandy with two crunching tackles left players flat on the floor! Jenna and Maddie combine well, which almost released the latter.

The game was fast and furious - Bournemouth were seeing a lot of the ball - but Keynsham were in this and causing problems for their visitors. Chloe produced two fantastic saves to keep the hosts in the lead.

(1-1) Bournemouth equalise after Keynsham over commit, and quickly take the lead moments later - when a good cross is well steered into the bottom corner (1-2) - BUT... Keynsham don't panic - Maddie feeds Jenna who calmly slots into the bottom corner to level the game once more (2-2)

MATCH REPORTS

Bournemouth are bossing possession - but Keynsham are battling superbly and are still a threat on the counter. A Bournemouth player benefits from a lucky ricochet but steers wide under pressure from Chloe and Tilly.

Nicky and Jessie show some really neat touches and passes forward - Ruby is working tirelessly in the CDM position. Chloe makes a superb save after a Bournemouth player wriggled free on the edge!

Keynsham force Bournemouth back - the ball breaks and Nicky fires in a superb left foot volley narrowly over! Keynsham are working hard - fresh cavalry is needed. Meg, Alice & Erin give Jenna Maddie & Jess a well earnt rest.

Keynsham fantastic play out from the back - Tilly to Martha - Martha releases Alice - Bournemouth superb last ditch tackle before Erin forces a corner. But, sadly, nothing came of it.

Meg forces another corner - Nicky tries her luck from distance - before Erin almost charges down a goalkeeper clearance.

HT - KEYNSHAM DEVS 2 vs BOURNEMOUTH DEVS 2

Keynsham had been absolutely superb - going toe to toe with a good Bournemouth Devs side. Loz for Jessie A the only half time change. A frantic start to the second half - Loz Nicky and Erin lead a Keynsham charge - Liv and Mandy with some great defending, before Bournemouth take a fortuitous lead when a shot deflected and span over the top of the stranded Chloe (2-3)

Keynsham almost equalise again - Loz free kick causes panic and Nicky's lobbed cross is steered over by Alice (slightly stretching)!

(4-2) a killer blow is landed by Bournemouth after Keynsham miss a couple of tackles and a Bournemouth player races thru and dinks over Chloe. Meg leads a charge - blocks a clearance and then fires narrowly off target, Keynsham are still giving this a go.

Bournemouth get their fifth, which is followed up soon after by their sixth, when an attempt block of a cross hits the Keynsham crossbar and Bournemouth head the rebound in. (2-6)

Keynsham have given this their all - and despite refreshing their team with regular subs, a lot of players are out on their feet. A seventh goal arrives. After some great football to be fair and a composed finish on the angle. (2-7)

Maddie superb thru ball - Jenna excellent pace and draws a good save from the Bournemouth keeper, the defence clears, before any Keynsham player can react.

Keynsham have got a bit of a second wind and are pinning Bournemouth back. Jessie pulls another goal back with a great turn and left footed finish! (3-7)!!

Chloe fantastic save - after a Bournemouth free kick had been blocked by the wall and the player sent in a fierce strike from the rebound!

Bournemouth add an 8th - after what looked a possible foul on Mandy challenging for a header. (3-8)

Keynsham to their absolute credit never give up and the game finishes with defeat, but a super proud performance!


