

Manager's notes

Today sees a Somerset County Senior Women's Cup Semi Final at home to Yeovil Town.

With similar colours, it is always the away side that has to change and Yeovil are expected to play in Yellow.

There are quite a few news items to list today.

Did you hear the broadcast of the 12 minute interview with 1st Team captain, Ciera Lundy and secretary, Pamela Newton on local radio KCRfm?. If you did not you can go to the station's web site (ktcrfm.com), where you can find the link to listen to catch up programmes. It is a very good listen by both club members.



The outstanding FAWNL fixture at Brisrol Rovers has now been fixed for Thursday 3rd April. The venue has yet to be confirmed, but we believe it will be at Mangotsfield United.

I can state that next week's away league game at Bridgwater United has been reversed to the AJN Stadium. Bridgwater's ground is not available to them.. In addition, the arrangement means that entry monies will remain with KTLFC and spectators will not face the much higher Bridgwater entry charges. Bridgwater will also pay for the food that we will prepare for after the game and will fund the cost of referees. The 1st team game v Bridgwater will kick off at 12 noon and the Development game v Exeter City will start at 3pm. There is a boys U16 match following that at 5-15pm.

A very good win for our Development side at Moneyfields last Sunday started the Southern Championship matches in great style with a 3-2 win. Two goals for our debutants from the U16 squad, an unfortunate head injury for Tilly W, which means that she will be out of football action for the advised 21-day recovery period. I understand that Tilly could not remember that she had scored beforehand.

I am pleased to announce that we have secured an important signing just before the registration deadline on Friday. This is a dual signing with Southampton Football Club and the player is Georgia Galley. Georgia has been playing in their U21 PGA team and is 18 years old with a good pedigree and is a mobile goal scoring forward, We thank Southampton Football Club for their cooperation in this matter and look forward to welcoming Georgia to Keynsham and working out when she will be available for Keynsham with no conflicting Southampton game. For Bristol City supporters, the Chairman has discovered that Georgia has an important family relative in John Galley who was a notable goalscorer for Bristol City with 84 goals in 172 appearances in the 1970s. I am sure everyone will welcome Georgia to the club and enjoy watching her play.

The Development Championship fixtures are now out and will see fixtures against Exeter City on the 23rd March and Queens Park Rangers on the 30th March with both games at home. There are additional matches in April

A reminder that on Sunday, our U18 players will have played their deciding league fixture against Weston Super Mare. kicking off at 10.30am. We are 3 points ahead and so this is a six pointer decider to clinch the League title.

The winners of today's semi final will face the winners of the other semi final (Bridgwater v Bishops Lydeard) at Paulton Rovers ground on Thursday evening 24th April.

SECRETARY'S VIEWS

Today is the Semi Final of the Senior Women's County cup and we welcome Yeovil Town Women to the AJN Stadium. Yeovil have had to change their kit colours today, as they normally play in green, similar to us, and they will be playing in yellow and black.

Two weeks ago when we played AFC Bournemouth the referee objected to our black socks so Bournemouth kindly lent us some green socks. I was therefore somewhat embarrassed to receive an aggrieved email from them a few days later, copied into the League, that several of the pairs of socks had been cut by our players. I had to apologise profusely and offer to pay for the socks which we had damaged. I am pleased to say most of our players have now volunteered to pay for the socks and I am back on "kind regards" terms with AFC Bournemouth.

A few late player registrations this week before the cut off deadline yesterday. Tomorrow I have to remember to deregister Ella before she returns to goalkeeping duties with Bristol City. Ella enjoyed her time with us and we all enjoyed having her and wish her all the best for the future in what promises to be an illustrious career.

Tuesday evening Ciera and myself were interviewed on Keynsham Town Community Radio FM regarding today's cup game, which was then broadcast on Thursday. The traffic in Keynsham was horrendous and I had difficulty finding the radio station but made it just in time. If only someone had said it was housed in what was once the rectory I would have found it easily. Ric had troubled pronouncing Ciera's name until I told him it was the same as Ford Sierra!

Final Note: At the last minute we heard that Weston Super Mare had pulled out from their game against our Girls in the Bristol Girls League U18 Division. The League say they will award us the 3 points so we have won the League which Weston were contenders for. It is however very disappointing not to have played the game which would have taken place this morning.

MATCH REPORT

SOUTH COAST SUCCESS FOR DEVS!!

Keynsham Devs travelled south to visit Moneyfields Reserves in their first game of the new split League format - called the Reserves Southern Championship.

In the original League format, Keynsham had narrowly lost twice to Moneyfields - 2-0 Away, having missed several excellent chances AND 3-2 at Home, having led 2-1 and given away two penalties. So Keynsham felt this was a winnable game and time for a bit of redemption.

The game started brightly by both teams - Moneyfields shaded the opening 15 minutes - with Chloe making one excellent save and the busier of both keepers.

Keynsham grew into their task. Jessie fed Jenna playing right wing & her dangerous low cross was well cleared by the MF defence.

Moneyfields were looking to play over the top and there were several occasions where each of the back four (Ella Tilly Amelie Lainey) and Zoe were called into action with some great strong and resolute defending on show.

Keynsham created an excellent chance, when Nicky superbly won the ball in the MF area and fed Angel whose shot was deflected for a corner. The corner was a good one from Nicky but cleared

Keynsham were having a good spell - a couple of offsides, where players were a bit too eager, saw breaks thwarted.

Jessie's good interception fed Jenna whose pass to Tia just took her wide and she can't quite wrap her foot around the cross

Before, Ella's quick throw in sees Tia run clear - and test the keeper on the angle! Keynsham were getting closer it seemed.

There was a brief break - as a MF player needed treatment we think having headed Nicky's corner earlier!

Chloe was called into action to sweep up a couple of threatening MF attacks. Jessie made another good pinch and released Zoe, whose driving run forward saw her shoot early, when she perhaps had more time and the keeper claimed.

Jenna finally breaks the offside trap and her cross sees Nicky fire over from close in - it was bouncing! Another great break by Keynsham - involving Tia & Angel sees Jessie run thru - but her dummy past the last player sees the ball run thru to the keeper and Jessie is penalised for challenging - harshly IMO!

Jenna was causing problems and her high press wins the ball, her excellent cross is this time narrowly flicked wide by Nicky beating the keeper to the ball. H

Tia & Jessie lead another good charge - Jenna nutmegs the keeper but the defender blocks her shot out for a corner! Nicky's dancing feet saw her send Tia through once more but the keeper stood up well and denied her effort.

Having been the stronger side for the last 25 mins - and very much in the ascendancy - Amelie does really well to defend a dangerous cross out for a corner. Keynsham clear & half time arrives with the game evenly poised and goalless.

MATCH REPORTS

Moneyfields started the second half strongly and a shot from close in is put wide, before Keynsham are forced to defend a corner.

Having weathered the initial second half storm, Keynsham took the lead on 48 mins - when Jenna cuts out a pass, beats the keeper to the ball and squares for Tilly W to score on her debut!! (1-0) H

Moneyfields almost replied immediately, when Keynsham played themselves into trouble at the back but a combination of Amelie, Tilly and Chloe sees Chloe claim the ball. 😵 🍪

Jenna creates another great attack - she feeds Angel who twists and turns for about 3 mins looking for an opening - before MF clear.

Keynsham are back on the front foot now and a good pinch by Zoe sees Jessie almost find Jess. There is a brief scare at the back as a low cross - that looked like it actually went out by the byline - is flashed across the face of goal and everyone misses it - but Lily is well positioned and manages to clear.

Jess almost gets on the end of Tilly's long ball forward. Before - Tilly makes a great block as MF have a bit of possession and start to find a few gaps.

Tilly W great little flick around the corner - sees Jessie race clear - she is a tad wide of the goal and sees her effort saved! Jenna then makes another great burst and her cross sees Angel unable to sort her feet out - the ball is recycled back and Jessie fires narrowly wide.

68 - the unfortunate Tilly W needs treatment after charging down the keepers clearance & landing awkwardly - Tia M returns.

Jessie's great pass sees Jess steer an effort on target, but she can't generate the necessary power.

In a hectic last 15 mins - MF equalise (first) when a player runs through and fires past Chloe. (1-1) 2 mins later - Keynsham regain the lead when Jessie drives forward, her pass may take a deflection but finds its way to Jess - who fires in an absolute worldie of a strike from the edge of the box!! (2-1)

AND 3 mins later it is 3-1. Jenna brilliantly gets to the byline and fins Tia with her cross, who duly smashes home!! H

The clock has almost reached 90 - but there will be a fair bit of injury time - with several stoppages in play.

Moneyfields set up a frantic finale - when their earlier goalscorer scores her second with a great clipped lob over Chloe. (3-2) - both Zoe and Jessie feel that they are fouled in the lead up to the goal.

Keynsham are determined not to be denied and are controlling possession, Jessie and Tia with a great interchange - sees Jessie almost open up - she is driven wide - Jess helps and Jessie forces a corner. The corner is partially cleared - but Keynsham have the ball and the referee blows for full time.

Respect

Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

Keynsham Town Football Club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed by everyone in a safe and positive environment.

I shall:

- Remain outside the field of play and behind the Designated Spectator Area (where provided).
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league, or County Welfare Officer
- · Required to meet with the club committee
- Required to attend an FA education course
- Required to leave the stadium during the match
- Suspended by the club from attending matches
- Suspended or fined by the County FA
- Required to leave the club along with any dependants




